Background

- 2019 CoverCO tour included a session on community conversations.
- The purpose of the session was for attendees to identify barriers affecting health, other than health coverage, in their community (e.g. transportation, food insecurity, housing, etc.).
- Attendees were asked to identify potential solutions or next steps to help address the barriers they identified. A common theme was to have access to centralized customer resources for customers like local foodbanks, affordable housing, etc.

Most Needed Resources - CoverCo Community Session Results

- During our time on the road with CoverCo we talked to the communities about other influences that they see in their area affecting health outcomes. There were consistent answers given to us from across the state. The most common answers in order of frequency:
 - Transportation
 - Mental Health
 - Housing
 - Food
 - Income (Employment)
 - Education
 - Community Engagement
 - Defined as lack of community resources such as Rec Centers, Interpreters and other community based services.
