

It's Open Enrollment!

Your current health plan will expire on December 31, 2022. In order to ensure you have coverage for 2023, you need to pick a new plan with a different health insurance company. Depending on what part of the state you live in, you should have at least one -- and up to six --other companies to choose a plan from that suits your needs. You can view 2023 plans using our free, online tool,

You don't have to pick a new plan alone! Our statewide network of Brokers and Assisters is here to help you.

Starting this Open Enrollment, every company that sells health insurance in the state must offer plans with a specific set of lower, fixed costs and make them available to everyone. These are called Colorado Option plans.

To avoid a gap in coverage, you should enroll in a new plan by Dec. 15 so that your coverage begins on Jan. 1, 2023









Social Media – Pushing deadlines and the value of shopping









Customers who received suggested plans are shopping

- 36,007 current customers received a suggested plan.
- As of December 8, ~45% of this population has already enrolled for PY2023.
- Only about 6% of the suggested plan submissions that have come through are enrolling in the suggested plan.
- ~94% of the suggested plan submissions have enrolled with a new plan other than the suggested plan.
- Approximately 55% have not yet enrolled.
