


Tax Time Enrollment

HB20-1236 (2020):

- Established the Health Care Coverage
 Easy Enrollment Program which gives
 Coloradans the opportunity to check a
 box on their state tax return to share
 their information with Connect for
 Health Colorado and the HCPF for the
 purpose of getting health coverage.
- Directed the Exchange Board of Directors to establish an advisory committee to help guide implementation and administration of the Easy Enrollment Program.

Process for Tax Time Enrollment Customers





To see if you or members of your household qualify for free or reduced-cost health coverage, check this box if:

- You are a Colorado resident and at least one person in your household does not have health coverage AND
- You give permission for the Colorado Department of Revenue to share the information on Form DR 0104EE with Connect for Health Colorado (the Colorado Health Benefit Exchange) and the Department of Health Care Policy & Financing.



Report a life change Select any Life Change Event you or someone in your household has experienced within the past 60 days. The loss of other health insurance can be reported up to 60 days before you lose the other insurance. Members of federally recognized tribes and Alaska Natives can enroll in coverage through Connect for Health Colorado any time of the year. Year 1: Enrollment

- As of October 16, 2022, Tax Time Enrollment box checks resulted in 1,687 enrollments for Connect for Health Colorado, and 59,201 positive eligibility determinations for Health First Colorado/CHP+.
- During program year 2022 (as of December 4, 2022), 147,000 households checked the box. These households consisted of 262,000 individuals, 93% of whom provided their email address.
- The average time from customer notification to plan submission in Connect for Health was 30 days.
 April was the most common enrollment month.

Program Year 2023: Upcoming Outreach

Program Year 2023: Upcoming Outreach


- Tax Help Colorado is the largest free tax preparation site helping folks under certain incomes with filing taxes. Policy presented at Tax Help Colorado's tax prep volunteer kickoff to explain the program and why they should ask their tax prep clients to check the box when appropriate.
- Policy created a training for the **Denver Asset Building Coalition**, the largest non-Tax Help Colorado free tax prep site, and Outreach supported a sponsorship for their organization.



Program Year 2023: Timeline

- DOR has already begun to transmit files to C4HCO
- In most circumstances, the tax filer will hear from Connect for Health Colorado about a week after filing their return.
- The Special Enrollment Period is effective for 60 days starting from the date that a person applies and receives application results from Connect for Health Colorado. Coverage will be effective on the 1st of the month following plan selection.
