

# Policy & Operations Committee Minutes February 26, 2022 3:00 PM – 5:00 PM

### I. Welcome & Introductions

Adam Fox called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m., welcoming everyone in attendance. The January Policy & Operations minutes were reviewed and approved.

## II. Partner Updates

#### DOI

Staff from the Division of Insurance (DOI) provided the Committee with a Legislative & Regulatory Update:

- Emergency Regulation <u>24-E-02</u>, Concerning Colorado Option Standardized Health Benefit Plans was adopted by the Commissioner of Insurance
- Emergency Regulation <u>24-E-03</u>, Concerning the methodology for calculating premium rate reductions for Colorado Option Standardized Health Benefit Plans was adopted by the Commissioner of Insurance
- SB24-093, Continuity of Health-Care Coverage Change, has passed
- <u>SB24-080</u>, Transparency in Health-Care Coverage, was introduced and is under consideration

#### **HCPF**

The Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (HCPF) provided the Committee with a Legislative Overview:

- HB 24-1146, Medicaid Provider Suspension, was signed into law on February 20.
  This las gives HCPF the authority to suspend Medicaid providers if they are suspected of participating in a criminal or fraud scheme
- HB24-1229, Presumptive Eligibility for Long-Term Care, will be in the House Health and Human Services Committee on March 6. This bill would give HCPF the authority to seek federal approval of a 1115 waiver to extend presumptive eligibility to individuals transitioning from the hospital to a community setting to streamline and ease that transition. HCPF has already been appropriated funds to cover the costs of these services, should the person be found not eligible
- HCPF figure setting will begin March 4, with the Office of Community living and Behavioral Health for 3 new bills:

- Medicaid for certain deferred action for childhood arrivals (DACA) recipients: dependent on dependent on the finalization of a pending federal rule that would allow HCPF to draw a federal match for certain DACA recipients
- Adding Autism Services to Child Health Plan Plus (CHP+): continued access to care for children transitioning from Medicaid to CHP+ during the PHE unwind, as well as expanding access for kids currently on CHP+
- Sunsetting Colorado Indigent Care Program (CICP): this bill would sunset the CICP program and add funds to the Primary Care Fund for 200-250% of Federal Poverty Level (FPL) to maintain access to care for individuals receiving care through CICP

# III. Legislative Session

### Legislative Update

Staff presented a <u>Legislative update</u> to the committee. The presentation highlighted HB24-1035, Modernize Health Benefit Exchange Governance, which the Board has taken a support position on.

Legislation for discussion include:

- SB24-073, Maximum Number of Employees to Qualify as Small Employer
  - No recommendation required because this bill does not directly affect Connect for Health Colorado

Legislation for Recommendation:

- SB024-093, Continuity of Health-Care Coverage Change
  - This bill directly affects Connect for Health Colorado, and the staff recommendation is for the Committee to take a position of s

The Committee accepted a position of support for SB024-093 and will be moved to the Board for discussion and approval.
