

Dear Mr. Patterson and Members of the Executive Team (and other pertinent stakeholders),

My name is Brian Kerby, a concerned citizen and taxpayer in the State of Colorado. I write regarding the recent audit of Connect for Health Colorado that revealed **thousands of dollars in questionable donations and credit-card purchases**, as reported by CBS Colorado. The findings raise serious concerns about governance, accountability, and the stewardship of public resources.

Specifically:

- The audit indicates that taxpayers' funds may have been used for donations to non-core causes and for credit-card purchases that lack clear justification or alignment with the mission of Connect for Health Colorado.
- Such use of funds undermines public trust in the organisation, and raises the question of whether the leadership and oversight mechanisms are sufficient to prevent these kinds of irregularities.
- Given the scale of the issue and the reputational risk, I believe the Board and Executive team must act swiftly and transparently to restore confidence.

Therefore I formally request that Connect for Health Colorado take the following actions without delay:

1. A public statement acknowledging the full scope of the audit findings, including all questionable expenditures.
2. A detailed disclosure of what corrective actions and disciplinary steps the Board and Executive are implementing (including any review of the individuals responsible).
3. An independent forensic review of all spending over the past [specify if you wish, e.g., 2–3 years], with the findings made publicly available.
4. **A clear timeline by which the Board will evaluate leadership accountability — including, if warranted, termination of any individual whose actions constitute a breach of fiduciary duty or misuse of public funds.**

As a taxpayer, I expect nothing less than rigorous accountability. The credibility of Connect for Health Colorado depends on it.

I look forward to your prompt response with a clear plan of action.
